Here are their responses:</a> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Cost? <a href="#">A roundabout will be approx. \$2,600, annually; a traffic light will be approx. \$13,000, annually.</a></li> <li>○ Was a survey conducted? <a href="#">The plans were discussed with MLP (Maui Lani Partners); decisions were based mainly on safety, cost, from what I heard.</a></li> <li>○ What's the timeline? <a href="#">The project will take 5</a></li> </ul> </li> </ul>		

	<p>- 7 months; they are planning construction to be most intense when school is not in session. They'd like to start in May. Yes; there are 4 on Maui. Roundabouts, compared to Traffic Lights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ - have proven to be safer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ &gt;90% reduction in fatalities</li> <li>■ 76% reduction in injuries</li> <li>■ 35% reduction in all crashes</li> <li>■ Almost completely eliminates T-bone collisions &amp; head-on collisions b/c it eliminates 75% conflict points (less places to hit with far greater impact when there are)</li> <li>■ Force people to drive slower; not faster (yellow is NOT the new green); Vehicle speed reduction = pedestrian survival</li> <li>■ Have 50% fewer pedestrian conflict points bcz they have shorter, setback crossing (there's a break/rest point in crosswalks called "splitter islands") which provide mid-crossing refuge and allow the pedestrians to focus on traffic from one direction at a time.</li> <li>■ Will have a crosswalk with pedestrian-initiated (solar) flashing lights</li> <li>■ Will have bike ramps to access multi use paths</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ - reduce congestion <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Wait time to get through intersection is less</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ - are environmentally friendly <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Less CO2 emissions with less congestion at the stop signs</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ - reduce annual cost/maintenance</li> <li>○ - offer flexibility for future growth</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Have roundabouts been used in busy intersections? <b>yes</b></li> <li>○ Why did he make a proposal for roundabout? <b>Safety</b></li> <li>○ Why a roundabout instead of a traffic light? <b>safety, cost</b></li> <li>○ How do we train people to use it?
